Bordetella Vaccine Release

I give permission to Ralston Valley Canine, to administer a single dose, oral Bordetella vaccination/booster to my dog(s); and, ☐ I agree that, as the signer, I am responsible for the medical care of this dog, that I am the direct owner of this dog, or I have been given permission by the owner to sign on their behalf (agent of the dog). ☐ I understand that the Bordetella vaccine may give my dog side effects, including but not limited to, nasal discharge, mild fever, lethargy, and/or loss of appetite. (Symptoms are normal and should not last longer than 1 to 2 days.) From the manufacturer: "Use of this product can cause inflammatory immune-mediated hypersensitivity reactions and/or anaphylaxis. Antidotes of antihistamines, corticosteroids, and epinephrine could all be necessary based on the severity and nature of the reaction." I understand that if my dog experiences any of these side effects that I am responsible for any resulting veterinary care and costs. ☐ I understand that the Bordetella vaccine is not fool-proof and does not guarantee that my dog will not catch canine "kennel cough." I understand that this is a live vaccine (Bordetella Bronchiseptica) and can temporarily weaken my dog's immune system. ☐ I attest that my dog: 1) is not pregnant, 2) is free from parasites, 4) is currently healthy, and 4) is due for Bordetella vaccination (avoid over-vaccination). The Bordetella vaccine is recommended to be given at least 2 weeks prior to boarding, though may be effective as early as 72 hours after administered.
